Our next Associate Pastor is expected to serve as the staff member with primary responsibility and oversight for the ministries related to children, youth, young adults and Christian education/formation for all ages, as well as share with the Senior Minister in pastoral responsibilities for the congregation, with opportunities for preaching and weekly worship leadership as well.

Located in northern Colorado, just north of Denver, Fort Collins is home to Colorado State University and an outstanding public school system. Fort Collins offers a unique blend of natural

Fort Collins is nestled against the foothills of the Rocky Mountains and alongside the banks of the Cache La Poudre River, and lies approximately 5,000 feet above sea level. Fort Collins' approximately 144,000 residents enjoy a moderate, four season climate with an average of 300 days of sunshine and 14.5 inches of precipitation a year.

Fort Collins has been named one of the best places to live in America by a number of national trend sources due to its attractive amenities, good weather, location and all-around livability. Key attributes:
